B.amp Mono Power Amplifiers



The B.amp mono is a single-channel amplifier built around a fully balanced circuit that's specified to deliver up to 500 Watts into a 4-ohm load and 300W into a typical 8-ohm load.

With a high-quality digital-to-analogue converter, streaming engine, and analogue preamplifier that control a 120-watt Class AB stereo power amplifier, the Alpha One is heavily loaded.
